- How many Psychology students can you accept for the academic year 2022/23?
 - → 1 student for the full academic year
- Mobility possible for one semester?
 - → Mobility is possible for fall semester only or the full academic year. No spring intake currently exists therefore this is not possible for 22/23. May change in future.

- Possible to take courses in other disciplines?

- → Not possible due to timetable constraints. Students will be informed if this changes.
- Must exchange students meet ECTS requirements per semester/academic year?
 - → Ideally students should be taking 30 ECTS per semester to follow a full-time study worth of credits to maintain their student status but exceptions can be made with agreement from home university.
- Do you have courses held in English?
 - → Yes, all courses taught in English
- Semester dates (incl. orientation, exams):
 - → 19 September 2022 Friday 26 May 2023 (full academic year). Students only coming for Autumn term would finish Friday 16 December 2022.
- Nomination deadline for winter (fall) and summer (spring) semester:
 - → 8 April 2022 for fall semester/full academic year. Spring semester intake does not exist.
- Application deadline for winter (fall) and summer (spring) semester:
 - → Friday 9 May 2022 for fall semester/full academic year. Spring semester intake does not exist.
- Language of instruction (local/English/mix):
 - **→** English
- Language proficiency requirements (local/English):
 English Semester only students can use evidence from home institution but full year students need official language test certificates. Students need to be at IELTS 6.0 with a minimum score of 5.5 in each component (equivalent to B2 CEFR). Full details of accepted tests available here.
- Housing options/website:
 - All exchange students coming to DMU for a semester are guaranteed accommodation at our <u>Castle Court</u> halls of residence (close to campus) if they complete their application before the given deadline. Students coming for the full academic year also have the option to apply for accommodation in our other <u>halls of residence</u>. Rooms will be subject to availability and prices may vary. Instructions for booking accommodation provided with acceptance letter.
